First two days

Day 1: Fly to Athens Greece and experience the tastes of Athens Metro baked goods. **Day 2:** Drive to Corinth and step on the exact same marble platform that Paul stood when he was tried (Acts 18 1-17).

Seven Cycling Days

Day 3: Ride to the medieval city of Nafplion circa 1453. **Day 4:** Ride through the city of Argos (Clash of the Titans).

Ride to the historic town of Tripolis circa 1821. **Day 5:** Sparta! **Day 6:** Kalamata as in Kalamata Olives. **Day 7:** The Homeric city of Pylos. **Day 8:** Ride along the Ionian Sea to Kaiafas. **Day 9:** Ride to Olympia, the birth place of the Olympic Games.

Last Day

Day 10: Drive back to the historic center of Athens. Walk to the Acropolis, the Agora, the first modern Olympics stadium and much more. Fly back the following day or extend your stay a few more days to visit a Greek isle, for example. We can recommend ways to spend an extra few days if you'd like.
